Background and Milestones

- NCMA achieved the designation as an *ANSI Accredited Standards Developer (ASD)* in 2018.
 - As an ASD, NCMA is authorized to develop and maintain American National Standards.
- Some of our significant milestones include:
 - In 2019, the *Contract Management Standard* was approved as an American National Standard by the ANSI Executive Standards Board.
 - Its designation was ANSI/NCMA ASD 1-2019
 - In 2022, the *Contract Management Standard* was reaffirmed as an American National Standard by the ANSI Executive Standards Board.
 - Its designation was updated to ANSI/NCMA ASD 1-2019 (R2022)

Discussion: Value Added of ANSI Accreditation

- ANSI accreditation through a consensus-based process will:
 - Provide stability and common language to our career field,
 - Identify meaningful job tasks and competencies, and
 - Provide a roadmap for targeted professional development.
- The rigorous ANSI accreditation process:
 - Contributes to continuous improvement and
 - Provides a bridge between formal standards and individual competence.

Issuance of New Work

On July 21, 2024, the NCMA Board Chair issued the following new work to the Standards Consensus Body:

Reaccredit NCMA as an ANSI Accredited Standards Developer, and reaffirm the Contract Management Standard [ANSI/NCMA ASD 2019-1 (R2022)] as a consortia standard in partnership with World Commerce & Contracting.

The intent of this new work is to prepare to actively participate in global standards development and maintenance provided by the International Organization for Standardization.

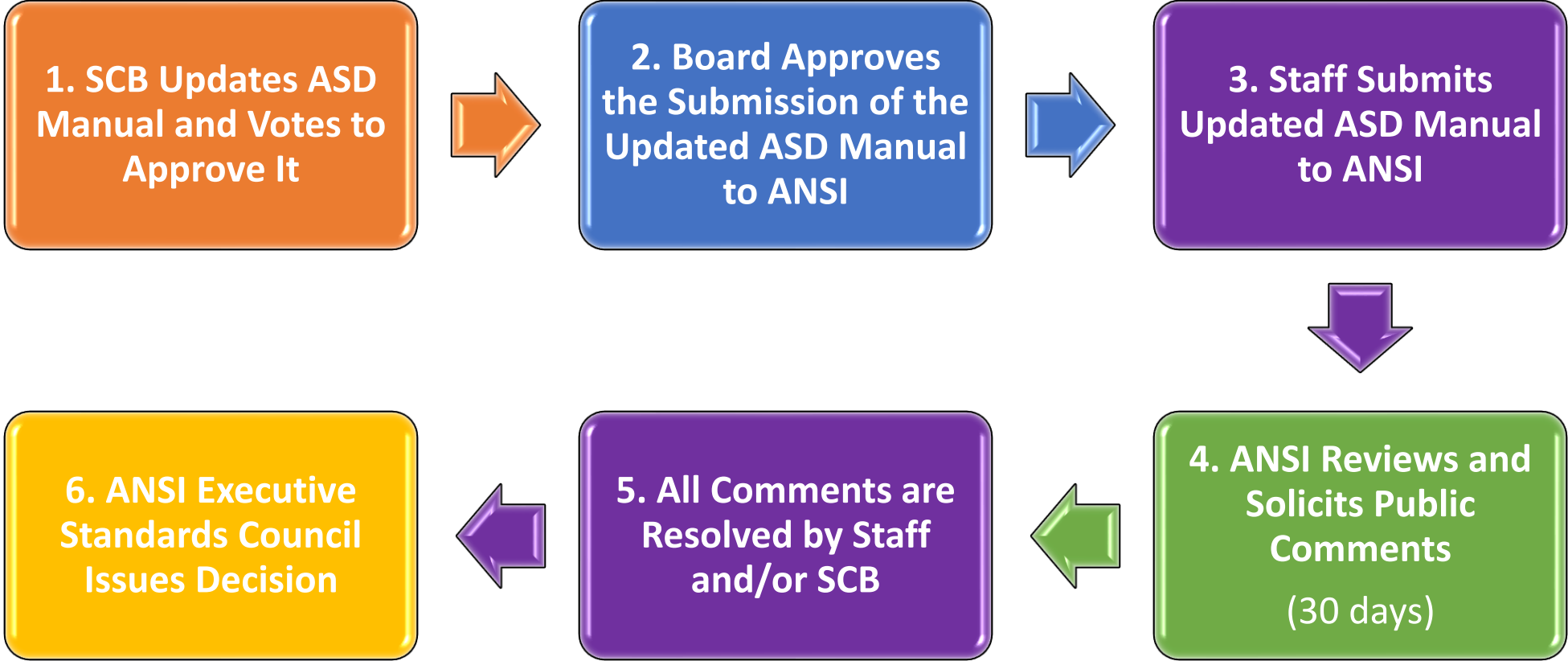

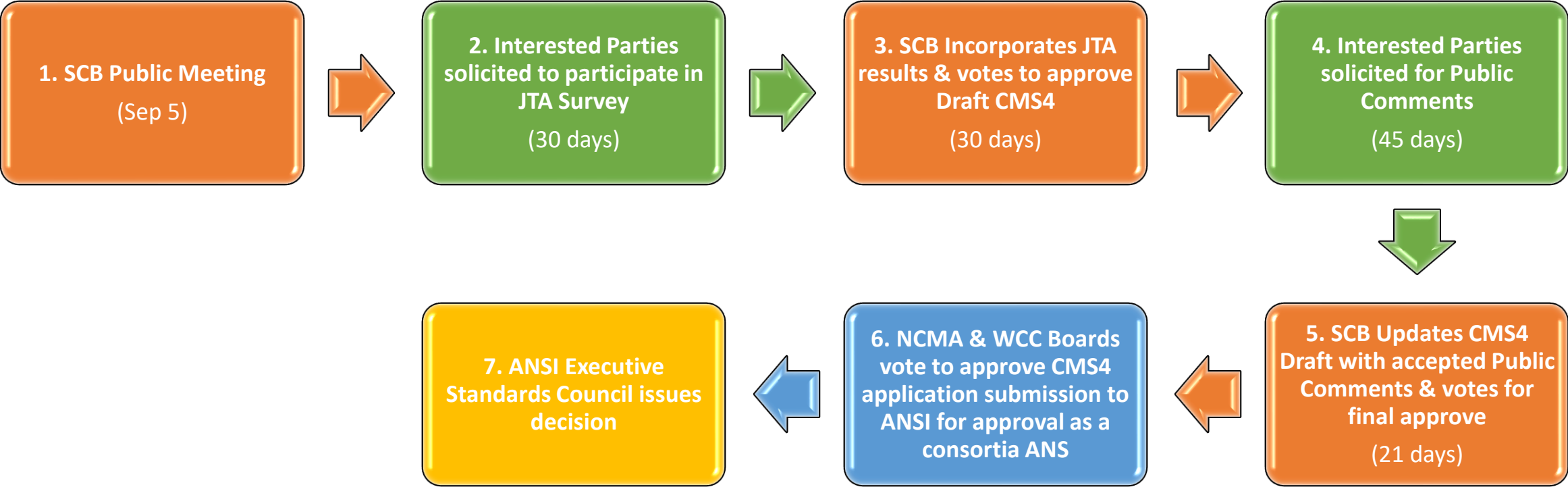

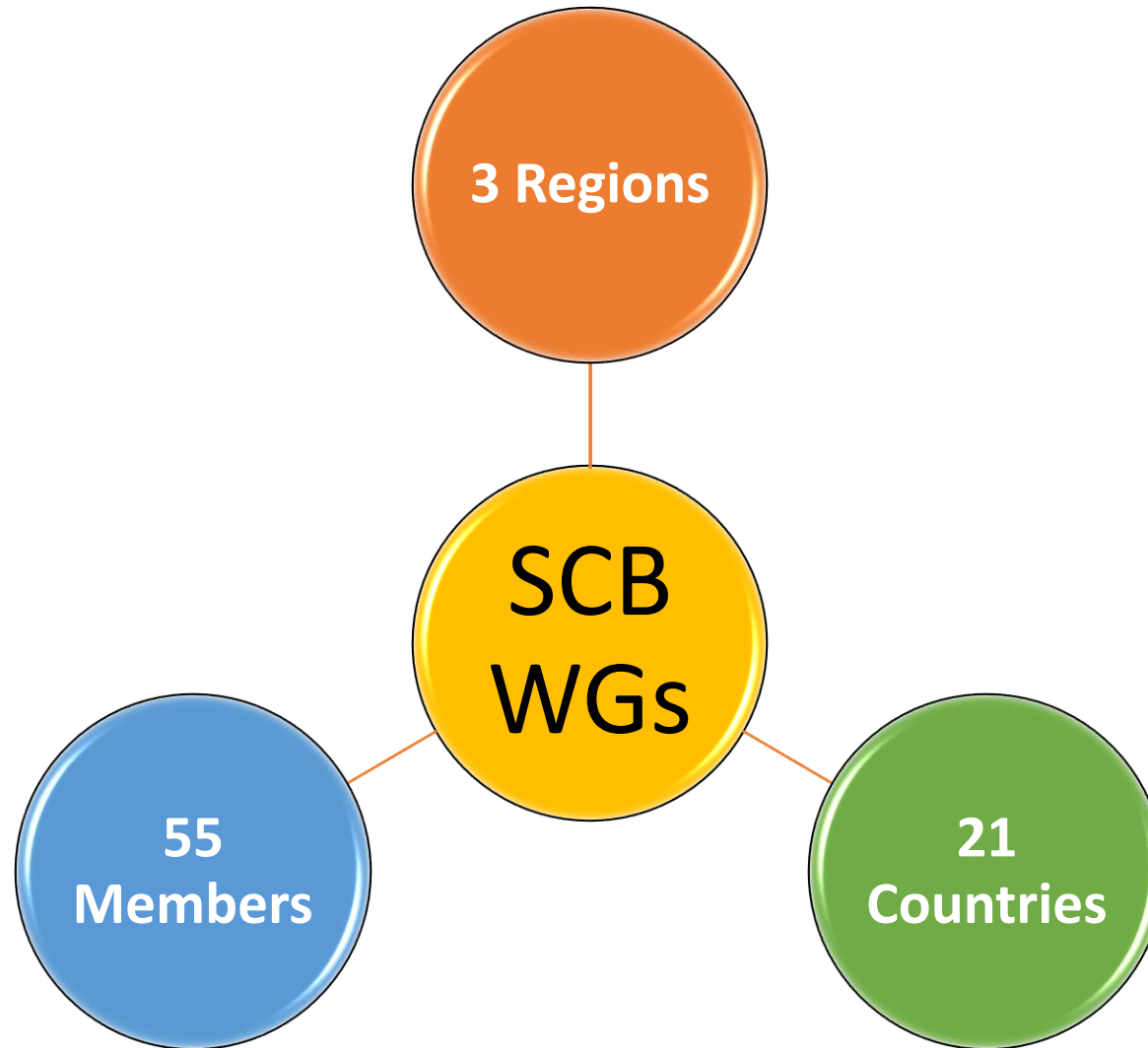
